	(except host NF). The team result will be calculated based on all 4			
	presented exercises. If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she must			
	present an exercise with each of the 4 apparatus and can qualify with each			
	apparatus for the Apparatus Finals. However, she won't be ranked in the			
	team ranking and won't get a medal/certificate for AA.

	application support letter must be sent to.		
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for		
	any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation
